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Hi Everyone,

You should have already received an email containing detailed information about our June Recital (if you did not receive this information, please contact us immediately).

This current form is the online form we mentioned in our last email that must be signed and returned to us (this form can either be filled out here and returned to us online, or printed and handed in to our front office). It contains a reminder of the policies and rules that we have in place to run the recital to keep the students safe, and it contains an insurance release form that Swarthmore College requires. Please complete, sign, and return this form to us by 01/14/2017.

## Studio Recital Policies

By signing below, I understand that if I am participating in the June Recital, the studio has an obligation to take care of and protect all of the families and children involved and that I and my family must abide by the following agreements. Some of the rules although inconvenient are necessary. Any family that cannot follow the rules listed below (or those delineated in the Recital Permission Letter) should not sign up to participate in our June Recitals.

- I have read our "Recital Sign in and Dismissal Policies" section of our Recital Information document which details procedures as to how and when students are admitted to and dismissed from the theater.
- I understand that I must wait until the end of the intermission, or the end of the entire show, to pick up my child from the dressing rooms. Students will be released from the dressing rooms only at these times.
- I will not take pictures using cell phones, cameras or video equipment during the actual Performances on June 2,3,4, 2017. (I may take pictures and videos at our Dress Rehearsal.
- Everyone in my party will turn off or set to vibrate all electronic equipment. Children may not play electronic games in the auditorium during the performances.
- At the Dress Rehearsal on May 30 & 31, 2017, I may video at any time in designated areas, but I may only use flash cameras during specified picture poses when we give permission.
- I understand that the auditorium doors will not be opened during the performance while dances are being performed. They will only be opened in between numbers.

- I will not eat food in the dressing rooms or bring food into the auditorium. I may eat in the lobby of the theater.
- If I am attending two shows on the same day, I understand that the auditorium must be completely cleared between the shows and that any items left on seats will be placed in the "Lost and Found".
- I will not be disruptive at the Dress Rehearsal or at the Performances; I will handle myself calmly and bring any difficulties to the attention of the director.
- I understand that the percentage of time my child spends on stage in their Recital Dance is dependent upon their percentage of attendance in classes leading up to the Recital.
- I understand that several classes (listed in the Recital Information Letter) perform in more than one show. We choreograph dances based upon the assumption that students are participating in all of the shows that their classes are in. If students notify us at the last minute that they are not participating in all the shows they are listed for, the student may have to be removed from sections of their dances to make the dances work.
- Swarthmore College, in the past, has wanted us to ban Dream Duffle Bags (extremely large dance bag with collapsible clothing rack). Last year, several parents offered to police the dressing room areas to keep the bags out of fire code areas. If parents are again available to police the dressing rooms this year, Dream Duffle Bags will be allowed. I understand that if parents are not available to police the dressing areas that Dream Duffle Bags will not be allowed at the recital.
- I understand that if I am Volunteering for the recitals, I may not save seats in the Auditorium prior to the doors officially opening.

**I understand that if I or my family chooses not follow these rules that:**

- Any future agreements and commitments that the studio has made with me and/or my family will be absolved.
- The studio is no longer under any obligation to provide a place for myself or my child at the recital.
- No monies paid for tuition, costumes, tickets, or recital fees will be refunded; and any past monies still owed to the studio, must be paid.
- The studio is not required to honor any future agreements that may have been made with respect to future programs the studio offers (e.g. for Summer Camps, and/or for Pre-Fall Registrations). Note: Any monies, paid toward these future events will be refunded.
